proceeds for and on behalf of Donald MacLean my
grandson the natural son of Hugh MacLean and
Jean McBain mother the said Donald MacLean comes
of age and then to pay the same over to him with
accumulated interest from and payable to my
daughter my body clothes to be divided and apportioned

amongst them Sean and Siara a little before
 and during unto the said John Blantoun and John
 James Bonnar and their heirs all my real estate
 whatsoever and wheresoever situated I do hereby give
 to let the same or otherwise as they may think ne-
 cessary until my grandson the said Donald
 MacLean attains his majority Then to the said
 Donald MacLean his heirs and assigns for ever
 PROVIDED always that in case the said Donald
 MacLean shall die before attaining Majority or
 without having lawfully issue then the whole of my
 real and personal estate shall be divided equally
 among my daughters Sean and Siara without
 the control of their respective husbands ~~See witness~~
 whereof I the said Blantoun MacLean have to this my last
 Will and Testament set my hand and seal this seventeenth
 day of April one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven
