**Allan Christopher Lancelot Duncan McLean** born 20/1/1903 at Narrabeen.

Parents : Mary McLEAN & Donald 'Rover' McLean

Grandparents : Christina McLean (nee Black) & Hugh (the elder) McLean

G-Grandparents : Christina McLean (nee McPhee) & Donald McLean

By the time of his birth the eldest children were registering and caring for the new arrivals and let their fancy roam as to name. Allan is mistakenly said to have been the Narrabeen postmaster in 1925 but it was his younger brother Kindor who took over from their father. He probably worked in the family business.

Married: Gladys Chisolm c. 1930.

He died aged 33 on 15/11/1934.
