Allan MacLean(Snr) was declared insolvent at 2.45p.m. on May 3, 1882 as in regulation with the Insolvent Act of 1860.

Court ordered Allan MacLean indebted to John Cherry for £900.0.0

Meeting of Creditors.

Local Court House - to be held 16th May
10.00 of the clock in the forenoon.

Order for Bail - 3rd May

Discharged out of custody on sureties to Receiver of £150.0.0 for Allan MacLean's personal appearance in this Court when lawfully required until he shall have passed his last examination.

Recognizance - 4th May

Richard Livett Lander appeared to acknowledge he owed John Cherry £150.0.0 - condition Allan MacLean appear until passed his last examination - then above Recognize void, otherwise shall remain in full force and effect.

Form of Protection - 4th May

Hereby protected from arrest for debt until 13th June.

Mr. Tom Pike appointed Trustee and Mr. H.P. Downer retained for the estate.
