amongst them share and share alike I give and devise unto the said John Cheriton and John James Bonner and their heirs all my real estate whatsoever and whosoever situate upon trust to let the same or otherwise as they may think necessary until my grandson the said Donald MacLean attains his majority; then to the said Donald MacLean his heirs and assigns forever provided always that in case the said Donald MacLean shall die before attaining majority without having lawful issue then the whole of my real and personal estate shall be divided equally among my daughters share and share alike without the control of their respective husbands.
