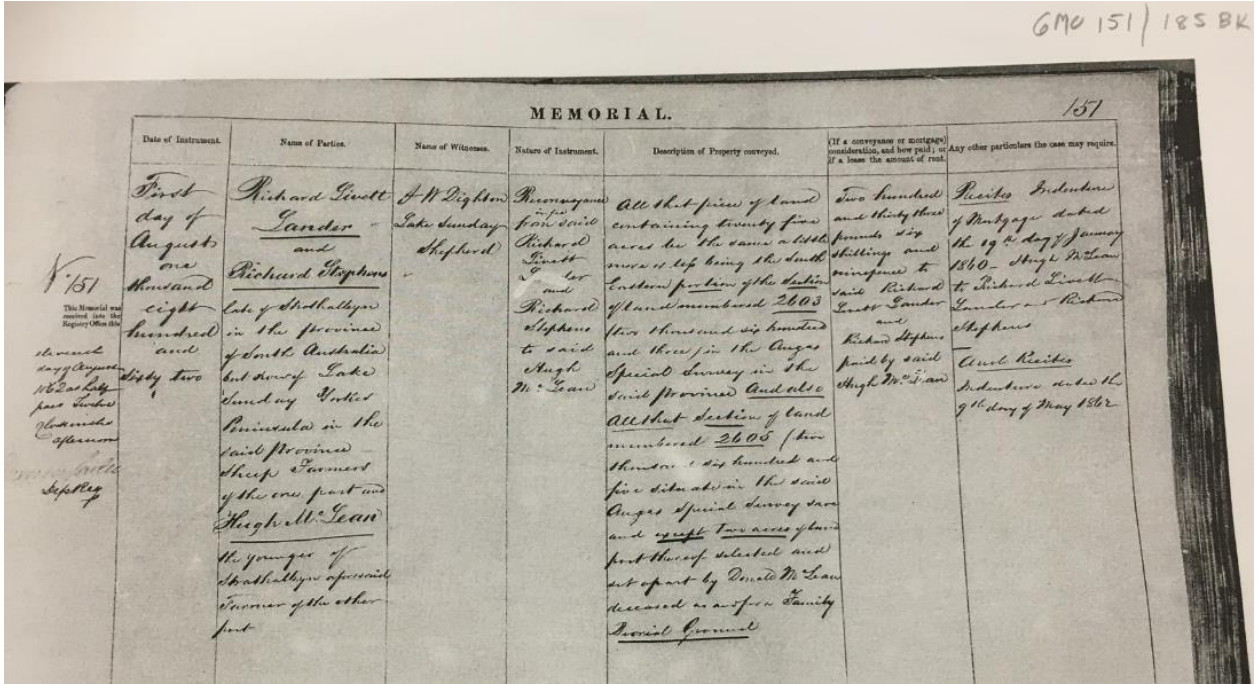


# Purchase by Hugh (the younger) McLean

on 1<sup>st</sup> Aug 1862 for 233 pounds & six shillings & 6 pence of part of Country Section 2605

- 25 acres on the southern end of 2605, excluding 2 acres for Donald's family burial ground
