in 1862 for £233/6/6

– 25 acres as the south eastern part of section 2603 and all of 2605 (excluding 2 acres burial grounds)

Name of parties: Richard Livett Lander and Richard Stephens late of Strathalbyn in the province of South Australia but now of Lake Sunday x? Peninsula in the said province Sheep Farmers of he one past and Hugh McLean-the younger of Strathalbyn aforesaid Farmer of the other part.

Nature of instrument: Reconveyance in for from said Richard Livett Lander and Richard Stephens to said Hugh McLean

Description of property conveyed: All that piece of land containing twenty five acres be the same a little more or less being the south eastern portion of the section of land numbered 2603 - two thousand six hundred and three in the said Angas Special Survey in the said province and also that section of land numbered 2605 (two thousand six hundred and five) situated in the said Angas Special Survey save and except two acres of land part thereof selected and set apart by Donald McLean deceased as and for a Family Burial Ground.

(If a conveyance or mortgage) consideration and how paid, or if an lease the amount of rent: Two hundred and thirty three pounds six shilling and sixpence to said Richard Lovett Lander and Richard Stephens paid by said Hugh McLean
