Generally weather can be expected to be fine and warm to hot at this time of the year. About 30° average.

REGISTRATION FORM

I hope that no difficulty will be experienced in completing the form, but get in touch with me if you have any problems.

If you are aware of persons who desire a copy of registration form, and have not received a copy from me. Either have a photo-stat copy of yours made, or ask them to write to me - copy will be sent forthwith.

PROGRAMME.

The trip in motorcade procession has been decided on in preference to tour buses, principally on grounds of cost. It is important to be quite sure of various movements on SATURDANITH, 1988.

Assembly is at intersection of South Eastern Freeway, Glen Osmond Road, Portrush Road & Cross Road. The Old Colonial Restaurant carpark is obvious and spacious. We want to move off from there within a few minutes of 9 a.m.

Mountain Hut Inn is a short distance past junction of Mount Osmond Road and Freeway. There will be room there to rank the motorcade off the freeway in front of the Mountain Hut Inn. The road junction is on the left hand side, very obvious.

From here we proceed direct to Strathalbyn, taking the Mount Barker exit off the Freeway, turning right through outskirts of Mount Barker and veering left at the Oval & Showgrounds onto the Wistow Road.

At Wistow we turn right towards Strathalbyn.

HISTORY AT THIS POINT.

Donald & Christina only traversed Freeway very briefly, their bullock wagon haul was through Crafers, Stirling, Aldgate, Mylor, Echunga, Macclesfield into Strathalbyn. Present highway to Strathalbyn by-passes all these towns.

ENTERING STRATHALBYN
