OBELISK & PLAQUE.

Secretary reported that shortly following the erection and official unveiling of the Donald & Christina obelisk and plaque in Richmond Road, Marleston, an unknown motor vehicle had collided heavily with it and completely demolished it.

This was fortunately noticed by a member of the Sturtzel family shortly after the occurrence, and the damaged property recovered.

This was reported to the City of West Torrens by me when it was ascertained that as it was an Council approved monument, and that it was covered by Council's Public Risk insurance policy.

The obelisk has been reconstructed in new materials identical to the original, and plaque has been straightened and repaired by the makers, and whole structure is now replaced on the original site.

The cost \$160.00 will be met by the City of West Torrens Council.

I am writing to you on behalf of the McLean Family History Organization Steering Committee, in respect to the life history of the undernamed:-

We are seeking to enlist the help of as many family members as possible to each work on one particular person in the family hierarchy. This work is being divided out on the basis of who we consider is best able to research the particular family member. It is fully realized that our request may at first appear almost futile to gather any information! On the other hand thoughtful assessment of the possibilities of gaining valid life history knowledge of the person involved, will often point to where a start can be made.

It is assumed you will contact me on any problem arising.

This is solely an information and life history at this stage, grammar and literary skill are unimportant. We are particularly seeking to ascertain how the person lived, what they did, their outlook on life, how they related to the community, what were their interests in all respects, personal anecdotes about them, keeping in mind being factual.

Some sources of information are:- Birth, Marriage & Death records, Church & School records, Property Ownership, Sporting & Club activities, Lodge records (particularly Lodges now mostly defunct), Local Newspapers, Councils, Hospitals, National Trusts, sources of records such as local storekeepers, etc, Shipping, Railway and other Transport records, Local Publications of any type i.e. programmes, race books, etc, Early records in bound books of any type are worth examining, Libraries, Medical Records, Banks, Books published by other families or any type of information in possession of other families (this can be very VALUABLE), recollections of old people in area where he or she last lived - these are some starting points.

Firstly, establish the person's family tree, starting from the Donald & Christina McLean son or daughter, descending to present day; report to me if you wish to shed some of the investigational work load arising from the progress of your assignment.

Please use this type of A4 paper in reporting information, note eylets are reinforced. This can be obtained at most stationers.

Try to let me know by 1/11/88 as to your progress.
