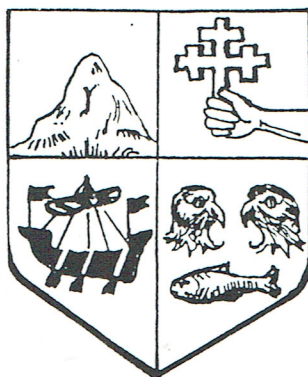
1. RECEIVE THE OFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING, HELD ON 31/7/94.

ARCHIBALD McLEAN. I expect Dianne Facey will be at meeting to comment. Completed subject to alterations and corrections.

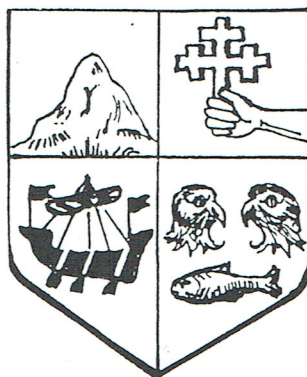
