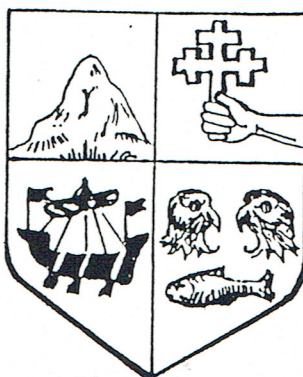

be completed this coming week.

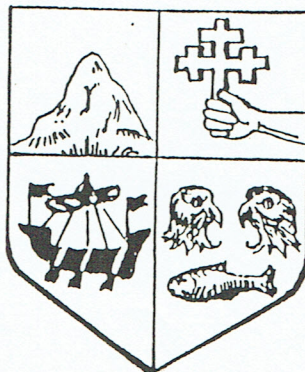

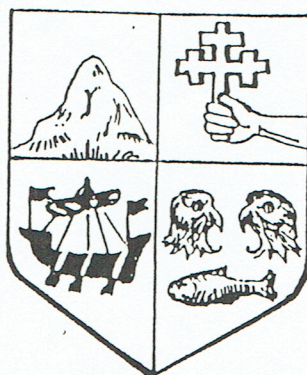

SECRETARY'S REPORT TO BOOK COMMITTEE ON SUNDAY 2ND APRIL, 1995.

1. D&C McLEAN MANUSCRIPT You'll notice I am now using a different term to refer to this item, as far as I know at this time I only have some extra material to add to Donald Henry McLean descendants under JOHN McLEAN. It is submitted as finished (E. & O.E.). The next step to the manuscript is to read it and correct any typographical errors, compile index and table of contents (edit both), at the same time counting blank pages for photographs at the same time indexing names on photos. Check where an odd sentence stands alone at top or bottom of a page. Then reprint for photo-copying. We expect to finish this on 21/4/95, then commence photocopying. We have allowed for an unexpected hitch or two, planning to start photo-copying on weekend of 22nd/23rd April, 1995. I would expect to finish the 700 copies on Sunday 30/4/95. 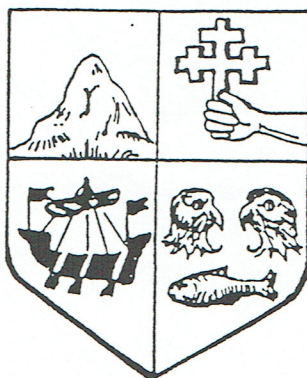

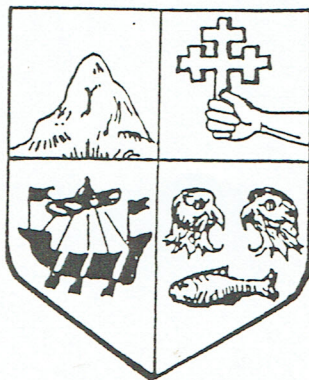

The style of gold lettering, cloth, and emblems will be for inspection at the meeting.

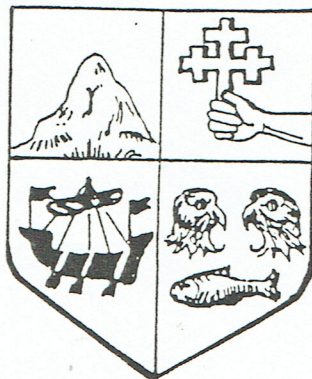
