

This complete history is bound in red cover, with gold lettering "HISTORY OF DONALD & CHRISTINA McLEAN & THEIR DESCENDANTS FIRST WHEAT CROP GROWERS IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA 1838" with McLEAN emblem in colour on front cover.

It covers the life of Donald & Christina, and their 10 children ALLAN, HUGH (ELDER), JOHN, MARY, ARCHIBALD, ANN, RACHEL, MARGARET, JANE, & HUGH (TOUNGER), and their descendants. It has hundreds of photographs, as well as reproduced documents, etc interest. It is considered a reliable history to the present day. Actually 4 descendants have died since the Book Launch.

I am anxious to be kept notified of all births, deaths, & marriages, (with full detail) so that our Official Record Book (being a book as printed so allocated) can be kept up to date. Your details are included as at present.


