Biography as published in 1995

Catherine was born 28/5/1884.

Parents : Catherine (nee McLean) & Alfred Bradley

Grandparents : Catherine (nee Dawson) & Allan McLean

G-Grandparents : Jane (nee Hamilton) & James Dawson and Christina (McPhee) & Donald McLean

Married: Douglas Gordon Scott (b. 19/3/1882).

Deaths:

- He died aged 45 years on 2/8/1927. A
- Kate died aged 72 on 6/11/1956.

Residence: Bunbury, Claremont and Kelmscott. W.A.

Kate trained as a teacher and taught at Naracoorte School from 1907 until her marriage in 1912. By 1920 they had a small orchard property and Douglas retained his position with the Commonwealth Military Forces. He died young at the age of 45 after a heart attack in 1927.

They were still in W.A.
