Estella Christine McLean born 9/4/1893 at Beulah, Victoria.

Parents : Maria Elizabeth McLean (nee Kruger) & Charles Soward McLean

Grandparents : Anna Soward McLean (nee Janeway) & Archibald McLean

G-Grandparents : Christina McLean (nee McPhee) & Donald McLean

Estella remained at home to aid her mother, and was about 19 when the family moved to Kongorong_ S.A.

Married: **Charles James Talbot** (b. 1/9/1882) farmer of Tantanoola, S.A. and a cousin of James Edward (Ted) Ashby, her sister Maria Mabel's husband. They dairy farmed at Moorak, S.A
