**James (Stanley) Keough** b. 21/7/1897 at Strathalbyn.

Parents : Christina McPhee Keough (nee McLean) & James Stanley Keough

Grandparents : Margaret McLean (nee Tannahill) & Hugh (the younger) McLean

G-Grandparents : Christina McLean (nee McPhee) & Donald McLean

He became a carpenter by trade after education at Strathalbyn and worked on wheat silos and at B.H.P. He also spent time at the Woomera Rocket Range He served with the R.A.A.F. Stanley retired back to Strathalbyn. Residence: Stoddan Street, Strathalbyn. Married: Ivy Winnifred McNichol Caskey (b. 28/3/1901).

Deaths:

Stanley Keough on 24/3/1973 aged 74 years.

Ivy died on 26/10/1974 aged 73 years. Both interred at Centennial Park.

1. Maxwell Stanley Keough b. 23/12/1924, Strathalbyn. Occupation: Carpenter and building contractor. Residence: Alice Springs. Married: Olive Bridges (b. 3/9/1930). Divorced. Four children – 1952, 1955, 1962 & 1964.
2. Gloria Christina Dawn Keough b. 5/11/1926. Married: Leslie Munro (b. 16/1/1911). Residence: Bayswater, Victoria. Four children – 1945, 1947, 1948 & 1950.
3. Brian Glenwynne Keough b. 1928 at Strathalbyn. His occupation: Carpenter and builder for his Uncle Robert (Bob) Keough. Married: Loretta Hartwig. Divorced. She remarried and had further family at Adelaide. She left Brian in July 1962 when her youngest child was aged 4 months. The close relatives rallied round and fostered the children to adulthood. Residence: until 1963 (Electoral Roll), North Parade, Strathalbyn. Death: Brian was later at a cottage in High St. Strathalbyn where he died on 5/3/1983 aged 55 years. Interred at Centennial Park Cemetery, Adelaide. By coincidence. his eldest son Brenton, was born on the same day date as Brenton's great uncle Robert (Bob) Keough, his second cousin Marie (Mrs Keller) and his grandfather Stanley Keough. Four children – 1956, 1958, 1960 & 1962 – all born in Strathalbyn.
